RE: Buy American Act & Trade Agreement Act

To Whom It May Concern:

Cascadia Metals supplies metallic-coated and pre-painted steel products that meet the United States Code (USC) Title 41 Buy American Act provisions in conjunction with USC Title 19, Chapter 13, Trade Agreement Act of 1979 governance.

The majority of metallic-coated and pre-painted steel products supplied by Cascadia Metals are purchased from approved countries as defined in USC Title 19, Chapter 13. As such, those Cascadia Metals' products are in compliance with the USC Title 41 Buy American Act.

Cascadia Metals will, on rare occasion, purchase product from suppliers who do not meet USC Title 19, Chapter 13, criteria. In those instances, the product will not comply with the USC Title 41 Buy American Act. Please notify your Cascadia Metals Sales Representative at time of quote if any building regulations mandate specific product requirements.

In addition to USC Title 41, there are numerous other federal, state, and local "Buy American" or "Buy America" regulations that mandate building products utilized in a project meet certain criteria. Our experience is that specific product requirements can vary widely between differing regulations and should be reviewed individually for each project.
